Hi everyone, here is the long awaited registration form for the trail trial! Remember, it will be at the 9th Street Equestrian Area (a new venue), I will include directions at the bottom of my email. Everyone is responsible for their own park entry fee (we will have envelopes at the sign in table) and please bring water for your horse as there is no running water at the park area. The trail is pretty nice-the only rocky spot is the parking area and the roads around it. Don't forget, we will have a lot of nice raffle items (donated by S & W Feed in Carson, Sierra Feed/The Saddlery in Reno, 1 Stop Ranch and Feed in Sparks, and Big R in Fallon) tickets are 1/\$1 or 6/\$5 and we will also have tickets available for our saddle raffle (ticket prices are \$5 per ticket or \$25 for six tickets). We also have some great prizes donated by Rogers Cowboy Supply (1st place), Sierra Feed/The Saddlery (2nd place), and possibly from Big R as well!

Please remember that we will not have age groups for this trail trial (all novices are in one division, all intermediates, etc) but you will get points based on how you are signed up with ATTA if you are an ATTA member. Also youth will ride the novice obstacles, and all riders under 18 must wear some kind of helmet.

Feel free to email for more info, and as always, you can either fill out and mail the entry form with payment (or let me know if you are paying the morning of the event), or you can just bring it with you the morning of the trail trial. See you on the 8th! If you know anyone else who would be interested in attending but they aren't on my email list, feel free to forward this email to them.

Directions: we will have a sign at 9th St. and at the gate of the park. From Yerington, take 95A North, cross the Carson River, and 9th St is the street at the top of the hill. Turn right, follow it all the way to the end (last mile is dirt road/gravel). When you go through the gate, follow the road to the left and it will bring you to the camp area. From Carson, you can take 50 East to Ramsey Weeks Cutoff, turn right, follow to the end, turn right on 95A and go south until you get to 9th St. Turn left and follow to the end. From Fernley/Fallon, take 95A south to 9th St and follow to 9th St, follow above directions.
